Dear Families, Residents, Responsible Parties, and Staff –

I am happy to let you know that the admissions freeze DPH placed on our center, has been lifted. As of today, we have no residents with the virus. We have one staff member that is in quarantine and is due back to work on Friday, 1/15. The parameter for allowing outside visitors to resume indoor visits is 14 days since the last staff and/or resident tested positive for COVID. As such, we will be able to resume visits early next week and I would encourage you to reach out to Genovia Morgan, our Life Enrichment Director at gmorgan@pavilionnsg.com to schedule a visit with your loved one.

I also wanted to give you an update regarding our COVID vaccine clinic that was conducted yesterday. Our residents and staff were thrilled they received their first dose and are looking forward to getting their 2nd dose on February 2nd. I am happy to report that those individuals that received the vaccine did not exhibit any negative side effects. I want to remind you that even once we are all vaccinated, all of us will still need to continue wearing masks, staying six feet apart, remaining at home as much as possible, good infection control practices including vigilance with hand hygiene, and proper PPE usage. We will also continue COVID surveillance testing of staff and residents as even though the vaccine (s) have a very high efficacy rate, we want to ensure we stay on top of this virus and ensure early detection.
